## Sarnia Elementary School Hockey Exhibition League

- 1. Teams will be divided up based primarily on the school that they attend (for demographic reasons). Grades 6-8 male or female players.
- 2. Every effort should be made to ensure that the offer to play in this league has been communicated to all players of age in their respective locale. Each team will be limited to 1 AAA player at each grade). This communication must indicate that this is a no hit league designed for fun and is a separate function operated outside of the school or school board.
- 3. If you can't fill the team roster from the respective school, you may bring up some players that are friends of your players. These players should be of house league caliber and in grade 6 or 7. There will be no outside grade 8 players allowed unless they played in the school league the prior year. The convener may also be able to help you fill the roster.
- 4. Please note that any "outside player" wishing to play in this league will be subject to transfer to a different team within the league in order to balance the league as best possible. It is the Individual Team Official's responsibility to ensure all outside players understand this prior to sign up.
- 5. A player must play at least 50% of regular season games to be qualified to play in playoffs or tournaments.
- 6. A completed team roster must be submitted to the league convener for approval, along with team payment prior to the start of the season.
- 7. The home team is responsible for obtaining a volunteer to take on the responsibility of time keeper.
- 8. All game sheets must be submitted to Jonathan Taylor with-In 24 Hrs of the completed game.
- 9. All games will be a 10 10 15 stop time with a 3 minute warm up. Games will have a curfew.
- 10. If your team wishes to conduct practices, additional ice time can be obtained through the league at your cost. All coaches / helpers that go on the ice must also have a completed waiver form prior to going on the ice. If you need assistance running a practice, please feel free to contact the convener.
- 11. We will follow the OHF/Alliance Hockey Rules with regards to penalties. The convener also has the right to extend any penalties or completely remove a player from the league that is not acting in a manner in which this league wishes to portray.
